WHEREAS, DR. RAJ KUMAR and the Gandhi International Institute for Peace continuously uplift the people of Hawaii by promoting nonviolence and peace, raising awareness about healthy living, educating the youth of Hawaii, and organizing and hosting community events that are open to the public; now, therefore,
